### **Coaching at Salem Baptist Christian School**

### **Job Description**

Reports to the Athletic Director, the Head Coach of the Women's Varsity Soccer program provides coaching, teaching & development, and supervisory responsibilities of the program. The Coach is also responsible for teaching and guiding students to their best performance in their respective sport. Finally, the Coach is responsible for creating a culture that honors our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in every aspect of the program.

### **Qualifications**

- Prior varsity soccer coaching experience within ages 13-18 years old, knowledge of the sport, and NFHS rules. Familiarity and experience with NCISAA regulations is not required but ideal.
- Clear required background check/employment screening.
- Maintain a current state of North Carolina driver's license.
- Christian conduct and character expected of all coaches at SBCS.
- Strong leadership with a commitment to both athletic and academic excellence within a scholastic environment.

### **Knowledge/Skills/Abilities**

- Provide overall leadership for the SBCS Varsity Soccer program and perform all services thereof as scheduled and/or directed by the SBCS Athletic Director.
- Responsible for the use, care, storage, and inventory of all SBCS athletic equipment issued for use by the sport program including, but not limited to uniforms, warm-up apparel, balls, and all other equipment necessary for practices and scheduled competitions.
- Proactively ensure the proper use, care, cleaning, and maintenance of all SBCS athletic facilities.
- Adhere to all rules, regulations and policies as mandated by the NCISAA and athletic conference.

- Promote the sport with students, alumni, and members of the community.
- Provide up-to-date scores and statistics to MaxPreps and report scores to the Athletic Director at the end of all competitions.
- Adhere to all rules and policies of SBCS Athletics and outlined in the SBCS Coach Handbook and the SBCS Athletic Handbook.
- Other duties as assigned per the position.

### **Compensation and Employment Status**

Coach positions are contractual for the designated period of the sport's season and are eligible for coaching stipends, which will be paid out at the end of the season.
