The Discovery Center at SBCS is for students who are functioning below grade level in reading and math and would benefit from smaller classes and more specialized instruction. The program is designed to enable the students to discover success and achievement in a small group setting, and at a pace that suits their individual needs. In addition to the academic program, students also receive life-skills instruction as well as participate in electives. Some students are able to mainstream into the regular academic classes when their skills reach the point that they will be successful in the class.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in special education is required
- Master's degree in special education is a plus
- ACSI or state teaching certification should be obtained within the first year of teaching

Experience:

- 2-5 years prior teaching experience in a special education classroom is preferred
- Prior experience working with special needs children in various church, work, and/or volunteer settings is required

Position Summary:

Discovery center teachers are responsible for teaching each subject from a biblical worldview while including a variety of teaching methods that accommodate the learning styles and abilities of all students in the classroom. They establish routines and procedures that promote learning, limit distractions, and facilitate a safe and welcoming environment. Teachers in this program differentiate lessons to meet the academic, spiritual, physical, social, and emotional needs of the individual students in their classroom. Communication with students, parents, coworkers, and administrators must be a priority through lesson planning, emails, FACTS, and meetings. All discovery center teachers will report to the discovery center director.

- Knowledge of IEPs, 504s, student accommodations, and testing used for students with learning differences
- Strong organizational and time management skills
- Innovative problem solving, creative lesson planning, and critical thinking skills
- Excellent collaboration and teamwork
- Clear and effective communication
- Ability to effectively implement technology into the classroom for both teacher and student use
